County / State Fair Information

It's almost time to start thinking about fair exhibits! If you are interested in showing in FFA at county or state fair, please read through the following information and contact Mr. Eischeid to get set up.

May 13: livestock nominations due for county/state fair beef, dairy, goats, horses, sheep, and swine and county fair poultry July 1: livestock entries due for state fair (including poultry and rabbit ID information) and county fair rabbits

Requirements for nomination may include tagging and pulling DNA (meat goats, sheep, swine). These arrangements must be made with Mr. Eischeid **ASAP**.

Carroll County Fair -- July 12-17 in Coon Rapids Crawford County Fair -- July 20-24 in Denison Iowa State Fair -- August 11-21 in Des Moines Iowa State Fair FFA entries, YQCA, and Code of Ethics forms due July 1

YQCA Certification

YQCA certification is required for all livestock exhibitors to show at county and state fairs. You may either choose to take the online training for \$12 or the instructor-led training for only \$3. Instructor-led trainings will be held with Mr. Eischeid on May 26 at 4:00P, May 31 at 5:00P, and June 15 at 6:00P. You must register and pay in advance. Note: all exhibitors that have graduated high school must take the \$12 online training.
